

PLACENTIA LITTLE LEAGUE MAJORS SPECIAL 2010 PLAYING RULES

(ALL OTHER RULES ARE COVERED IN THE LITTLE LEAGUE RULE BOOK)

1. THE GAME

Regulation games that end in a tie or deemed "rained out" shall be rescheduled, as soon as feasible, by the "Scheduler".

2. Batting

- a. The batting order shall be the entire team roster for the regular season.
- b. For the playoffs (post-season), the batting line-up shall follow traditional Little League rules as written in the green book for the Major Division.

3. UMPIRES

- a. If the assigned umpire is not available at game time, the ranking Board Officer present shall assign an umpire that is acceptable to both managers. Major Division games shall take precedence of Minor division games and an umpire may be reassigned accordingly. If an acceptable umpire cannot be scheduled 10 minutes past game time, the game may be postponed and rescheduled.

4. DIVISION STANDINGS AND PLAYOFFS

- a. The first half season divisional winner shall play the second half divisional winner in a playoff game(s) to determine the overall divisional winner for the season. One or three game playoff, if possible. Weather, time, and field availability to be considered by the Board of Directors.

5. PROTESTS (IN ADDITION TO LL RULEBOOK)

- a. Every effort must be made to avoid a protest. When submitting a written protest, an explanation must be included that clearly outlines steps taken to avoid the protest.
- b. If it is evident to the protest committee that little or no attempt was made to avoid the incident in question, the protest may be rejected. All individuals involved in a protest shall be notified of the protest and the alleged infraction. All individuals involved in the protest shall be notified of the date, time and place of the hearing at least 24 hours in advance of the scheduled protest hearing.
- c. In addition to a written protest, each manager may submit to the protest committee, either in writing or orally, a supplementary report regarding the alleged infraction.
- d. The protest committee shall have the power to request supplementary reports, either in writing or orally, from one or both managers regarding the alleged infraction.

6. OTHER SPECIAL PLAYING RULES

- A. Each player shall play one complete game per half of season.

- B. **Should a player fail to play the mandatory playing time per the LL Rulebook (excluding injury only), he/she shall start the next schedule game he/she attends, and play the entire game. This complete game shall not count as specified in Rule 7A.**

6. ALL-STAR NOMINATIONS – TO BE DETERMINED AT A LATER DATE.

PLEASE NOTE: SHOULD A MANAGER/COACH VIOLATE PLAYING TIME RULES (LITTLE LEAGUE RULEBOOK OR LOCAL RULE #7), THE MANAGER/COACH SHALL RECEIVE A WRITTEN NOTICE, ONE TO MULTIPLE GAME SUSPENSION AND OR SUSPENSION FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE SEASON.
