

2010 Fullerton/Placentia Alliance Local Rules

(Rev E) 2-23-2010

- Every Team will Bat the Bench
- Time Limit: The start time is kept by the umpire and shall be declared at the time of the first pitch. The start time shall be noted in the official home team scorebook.
 - Weekday games: A 2 hour no new inning and a 2 hour 15 minute “drop dead” curfew will apply on games played during the week when lights will be utilized.
 - Weekend games: A 2:15 no new inning and a 2:30 “drop dead” rule will apply.
- Mercy Rule is 10 runs after 5 innings.
- Balks: A balk “warning” will be given on games played thru 3/12/10. Games played from 3/13/10 to the end of the season the balks will be called without warning. Note: One (1) warning per pitcher, per game.
 - Field Set up: Games played prior to 3/26/10 the field size will be set up at 54/80 dimensions. All games played on or after 3/26/10 will be played at 60/90.
 - Note: a game in suspension before 3/26/10, but now rescheduled to finish on or after 3/26/10 will be played at 60/90.
- Pool Players: In the event a team does not have enough players to play a game, per the Little League rule book, a “pool player” may be placed on the team. The rule is clearly defined in rule V-Selection of Players, Paragraph (c). The player agents will determine the pool of available players and place a person to fill the void. Managers and coaches may not recruit players. They are only to inform the player agent of the need for a player(s). Pool players cannot pitch.
 - Note: if during the course of the game the original roster player arrives and the team now meets the nine-player requirement, then the borrowed player will be removed from the team.
- Each team will provide two game balls
- Pitch Count Requirement: Each team will be required to follow the 2010 pitch count requirements. The home book is the official keeper of pitches, but each team is encouraged to count the pitches and compare the count between innings.
 - Pitch Count Sheet: Each team will be required to fill out the pitch count sheet. Each team will sign the form and provide proof of available pitchers to the next opposing manager. **These sheets MUST be brought to the plate meeting at each game.**
 - A copy of the 2010 pitch count log can be found at www.ghll.net , click “Documents” on the left side of the screen, and then scroll down to “2010 Pitching Log”.
- With 2 outs in the inning a team may insert a courtesy runner for their catcher. The courtesy runner must be the last recorded out in the inning.
- TOC: Each league will determine their own TOC team, if any.
- Consolation Tournament: All teams not advancing to the TOC tournament will play in a tournament, to be determined at a later date.
- Discipline Action – If the occurrence takes place between 2 teams from the same league, discipline will be handled within that league. If the occurrence takes place between 2 teams from different leagues, the Presidents from the leagues will convene to discuss the matter. Green Book regulations for discipline action will be enforced (at a minimum).
